**EMERGENCY POWERS ACT**

**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021  
EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (HONIARA EMERGENCY ZONE)  
(RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OF VESSELS AND AIRCRAFT)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2022**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 17 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), and with reference to sections 36(a) and 65(2) of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

**1 Citation**

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Vessels and Aircraft) (Amendment) Order 2022*.

**2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

**3 Amendment of Legal Notice No. 15 of 2022**

This Order amends the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Vessels and Aircraft) Order 2022* (Legal Notice No. 15 of 2022) (“**Principal Order**”).

**4 Paragraph 6 amended**

Paragraph 6 of the Principal Order is amended by omitting subparagraph (4) and substituting:

“(4) Paragraph 5 does not apply to:

- (a) an aircraft operated by an authorised officer or an essential worker while performing his or her functions, responsibilities or duties; and
- (b) an aircraft operated for a purpose (which is not a purpose for an essential service) that has been approved by the Prime Minister in writing.”.
