## **EMERGENCY POWERS ACT**

### **EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS 2021**

### **EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXCEPTION FOR ENTRY INTO SOLOMON ISLANDS) (NO. 100) ORDER 2021**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 7 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 84 of 2021), and with reference to sections 36 and 65 of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

#### **1 Citation**

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Exception for Entry into Solomon Islands) (No. 100) Order 2021*.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

#### **3 Non-citizens who may enter Solomon Islands**

Each person specified in the Schedule may, on 2 May 2021, enter Solomon Islands under regulation 7(3) of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2021* despite the prohibition under regulation 7(1) of the Regulations.

#### **4 Amendment of Legal Notice 120 of 2021**

The *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exception for Entry into Solomon Islands)(No. 97) Order 2021* (Legal Notice 120 of 2021 published in Gazette No. 102 Supplement No. 88, 29 April 2021, page 321) is amended by omitting from Schedule 1 the name that is item number 1.13.
