## FOREST RESOURCES AND TIMBER UTILISATION ACT (Cap. 40)

## **EXEMPTION ORDER**

IN exercie of the powers conferred upon me by section 4 (1) (c) of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act (Cap. 40), I make this Order-

1. That the land referred to in Schedule 1 of this O~der ("the Land") is exempted from the provisions of section 4 of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act [Cap. 40] and the provisions of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Protected Species) Regulations 2012 including any subsequent amendments therein.

- 2. The Land shall be used for agricultural purposes as certified by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock Development.
- 3. All Felling of logs in the land shall comply with the terms and Conditions of the special permit to be issued by the Commissioner of Forest.
- 4. Logs felled under clause 3 of this Order shall be exported and / or sold pursuant to the laws of Solomon Islands.
- 5. Records of logs felled, exported and / or sold shall be furnished to the Commissioner of Forest within fourteen (14) days of the export and or sale of such logs.
- 6. A person who contravenes any of the clauses in this Order is deemed to have committed an offence under section 4 of the Act, as if the exemption were not granted under this Order.
