## LIQUOR ACT (Cap. 144)

## THE BANNING OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR ORDER 2014

IN exercise of the powers conferred under section 82 (1) of the Liquor Act, the Minister hereby makes the following Order –

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Banning of Sale of Liquor Order 2014 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.
- 2. No liquor shall be sold from any licensed retail premises including night clubs or Bottle Shops within Solomon Islands effective from the 18th November to 25th November 2014.
- 3. Any person who contravenes subsection (2) commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 2,000 penalty units or to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months.
- 4. The banning on sale by retail or supply of liquor does not apply to sale or supply of liquor by a hotel to its bona fide guest accommodated at the Hotel or at restaurant.
