**THE PRISONS (INJURIES AND DEATH BENEFIT)
REGULATIONS 1999.**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Prisons Act, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following Regulations

1. These Regulations may be cited as Prisons (Injuries and Death Benefit) Regulations, 1999.

2. Where any prison officer suffers injury in the course of duty, the Government shall be liable to pay such prison officer compensation in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.

3. Where any prison officer suffers injury in the course of duty which results in the death of such prison officer, the Government shall be liable to pay the dependants of such deceased prison officer compensation in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.

4. In these Regulations -

“injury” means injury which results in partial or total incapacity of a permanent nature.
