1. This Ordinance shall be entitled the Guadalcanal Province Ordinance 1994 and shall come into force upon approval of the Minister in accordance with Section 32 of the Provincial Government Act 1981 and publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

2. The appropriation of the Provincial Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of Seventeen Million Eight Hundred and Forty Six Thousand, Four Hundred and Sixty Eight dollars to be applied for the purpose specified in Section 36(2) of the Provincial Government Act 1981, and to the service of the Financial Year ending 31 March, 1995.
