### THE MAKIRA ULAWA PROVINCE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 1995

# AN ORDINANCE TO

# APPROPRIATE, TWO MILLION AND ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO DOLLARS TO THE SERVICE OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING 31 MARCH 1996.

Enacted by the Makira Ulawa Provincial Assembly.

### THE MAKIRA ULAWA PROVINCE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 1995

Short Title and Commencement.

1. This Ordinance shall be cited as the "Makira Ulawa Province Appropriation Ordinance 1995" and shall come into force upon assent by the Minister in accordance with section 32 of the Provincial Government Act 1981 and publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

2. The appropriation from the Provincial Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of Two Million and One Hundred and Fifty-Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and Eighty-Two Dollars to be applied for the purpose specified in sub-section 36(2) of the Provincial Government Act, and to the service of the Financial Year ending 31 March, 1996.

Appropriation. 3. The sum specified in the preceeding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads specified and in the amounts respectively in relation thereto, in the schedule to this Ordinance.

> Passed by the Makira Ulawa Provincial Assembly this twentyseventh day of June 1995.
