PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1981

THE TEMOTU PROVINCE
BUSINESS LICENCE ORDINANCE 1992

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATIONS,
CONTROL AND LICENSING OF BUSINESS AND OTHER
ACTIVITIES IN TEMOTU PROVINCE.

PRELIMINARY

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Temotu Province Business Licence Ordinance 1992 and shall come into operation after assent by the Minister for Provincial Government and upon publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

2. In this Ordinance -

“Assembly” means the Temotu Provincial Assembly;

“Authorised Officer” means any public officer or provincial employee authorised by the Executive for the purposes of this Ordinance;

“Business” means any activity or undertaking, service, trade, profession, occupation or other venture determined by the Executive to be a business (whether or not listed in Schedule 2) and carried out by any person for the purpose of gain, profit or payment of any kind, whether or not any such gain, profit or payment has been received, but does not include activities or services in the course of employment or as part of a charitable or community organisation or in a local market;

“Executive” means the Temotu Provincial Executive;

“Logging Sales” means the Business of selling timber whether milled or unmilled (including all “forest produce” as defined in the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act) or purchasing the same for resale but this does not
