THE WESTERN PROVINCE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 1994/1995

1. This Ordinance shall be entitled The Western Province Appropriation Ordinance 1994 and shall come into force upon the approval of the Minister in accordance with section 32 of the Provincial Government Act 1981 and publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

Short title and Commencement.

2. The appropriation from the Provincial Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of: FIVE MILLIONS EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY SEVEN THOUSANDS SIX HUNDRED & SIXTY FIVE DOLLARS AND SIXTY SIX CENTS to be applied for purposes specified in section 36(2) of the Provincial Government Act, and to the services of the Financial Year ending 31st March 1995.

Authorisation of issue of \$5,837,665.66 from the Provincial Fund.

3. The sum specified in preceeding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the Head (codes) specified and in the amount respectively specified in relation thereto in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
