**POLITICAL PARTIES INTEGRITY (POLITICAL PARTIES
COMMISSION) (REMUNERATION) REGULATIONS 2019**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the *Political Parties Integrity Act 2014*, I make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Political Parties Integrity (Political Parties Commission) (Remuneration) Regulations 2019*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Remuneration of Commissioners

A member of the Political Parties Commission must be paid the following remuneration for each sitting of the Commission:

CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) (SPEAKER) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act* (Cap. 84), I make the following Regulations:

1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Speaker) (Amendment) Regulations 2019*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

3 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the Principal regulations, *Constitutional Services (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Speaker) Regulations* (Legal Notice No. 144 of 1990).

4 Amendment of regulation 4

Regulation 4 is amended by deleting “\$8652.19” and substituting “\$8911.76”.

5 Amendment of regulation 6

Regulation 6 is amended by deleting “\$12 000.00” and substituting “\$15 000.00”.

6 Amendment of regulation 7

Regulation 7 is amended by deleting “\$4000.00” and substituting “\$5000.00”.

7 New Regulation 9

The Principal Regulations is amended by deleting regulation 9 and substituting the following:

“(9) 1 The Speaker shall be provided with a vehicle free of charge.

2 If the Speaker is not provided with a vehicle free of charge, he or she is entitled to the following allowances:

(a) monthly vehicle allowance – \$5000.00;

(b) monthly Fuel allowance – \$2000.00.

8 Amendment to regulation 12

Regulation 12(1) is amended by deleting “\$250.00” and substituting “\$350.00”.

9 Amendment to regulation 12A

Regulation 12A is amended by deleting “\$250.00” and substituting “\$300.00”.

10 Amendment to regulation 14

Regulation 14 is amended by deleting “\$10 000.00” and substituting “\$12 000.00”.

11 Amendment to regulation 16

Regulation 15 is amended by deleting “\$10 000.00” and substituting “\$12 000.00”.

12 Amendment to regulation 22

Regulation 22 is amended by deleting “\$150 000.00” and substituting “\$400 000.00”.

13 Amendment to regulation 23

Regulation 23 is amended by deleting “\$10 000.00” and substituting “\$15 000.00”.

14 New Regulation 24

A new regulation is inserted after regulation 23 as follows:

“24. The Speaker is entitled to a monthly telephone allowance of \$2000.00”.
