**MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (ENTITLEMENTSS) COMMISSION
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019**

The Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission, under section 69B(2) of the *Constitution*, make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission (Amendment) Regulations 2019*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 April 2019.

3 Regulations amended

These Regulations amend the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission Regulations 1988 (the 'principal Regulations')*.

4 Regulation 11C amended

Regulation 11C of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the table and replacing the following:

“Aggregate period of years served in Parliament (Column 1)	Percentage of salary for life pension (Column 2)
Up to 4 years	25%
Up to 8 years	30%
Up to 12 years	40%
Up to 16 years	45%
Up to 20 years	50%
Up to 24 years	55%
Above 24 years	65%

5 Regulation 70 amended

Regulation 70(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting “salaries,” after “All”.

6 Appendix A1 amended

Appendix A1 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraphs (a) to (e) and substituting the following:

“(a)	Prime Minister	\$307,919.52
(b)	Deputy Prime Minister	\$277,740.17
(c)	Ministers, Leader of Opposition Leader of Independent Group	\$242,439.08
(d)	Deputy Speaker, Chairperson of the Parliamentary Caucus, Chairperson of Parliamentary Standing Committees	\$219,703.37
(e)	Members	\$198,809.83.”
