THE SOLOMON ISLANDS VISITORS BUREAU ACT 1996 (No. 1 OF 1996)

THE VISITORS BUREAU REGULATIONS 1999

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 18 of the Solomon Islands Visitors Bureau Act 1996, and in consultation with the Board, I, Edmund Andresen, Minister of Commerce, Industries, Employment and Tourism, do hereby make the following regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Visitors Bureau Regulations 1999.
- 2. In these Regulations, the expression "licence" means a licence issued by the Board authorising a person to engage in any enterprise or tourist related service or facility.
- 3. (1) An application for the issue or renewal of a licence shall be made to the Board in Form 1 in the First Schedule.
- (2) A fee of one hundred dollars shall be paid to the Board in respect of the application.
- (3) If the application is refused the fee shall be refunded in full.
- 4. A licence shall be in Form 2 in the Second Schedule and, subject to section 10(1) of the Act, shall be valid for one year from the date it is issued or renewed.
- 5. A licence issued or renewed by the Board shall be subject to the following terms and conditions -
 - (a) the licensee shall keep and maintain his place of enterprise or service or facility in a good and internationally accepted hygienic condition;
 - (b) the licensee shall ensure acceptable standards of security, safety and privacy of the guests at his place of enterprise, service or facility;

- (c) the licensee shall within seven days, after the last day of each month, provide the Bureau with the following -
 - (i) a return, in Form 3 in the Third Schedule along with the authorised monthly bed levy in regard to his enterprise, service or facility, or other relevant monthly levy or fee:
 - (ii) information regarding any arrangement of staff training courses, whether locally or overseas;
- (d) the licensee shall provide current and correct information on his enterprise, service or facility at all times;
- the licensee shall afford to the Bureau all support necessary to promote and market Solomon Islands as a desirable holiday destination;
- the licensee shall inform the Bureau, or provide the Bureau with a copy, of any complaint made by any guest in regard to the conditions of services provided thereat;
- (g) the licensee shall comply with all reasonable instructions given by the Bureau, its servants or agents, in regard to the conditions of or services provided at his place of enterprise, service or facility;
- (h) the licensee shall not cause or permit to be caused in his place of enterprise, service or facility any act which is likely to disturb any guest;
- the licensee shall pay to the Board the appropriate licence fee determined by the Board;
- (j) the licensee shall adopt a Malaria control and management plan;
- (k) the licensee shall carry out and provide to the Bureau an environmental impact analysis of his enterprise, service or facility;
- (l) the licensee shall carry out and provide to the Bureau a socio-cultural impact analysis of his enterprise, service or facility;

- (m) the licensee shall respect the customs and culture of the people of Solomon Islands at all times;
- (n) the licensee shall provide and display in conspicuous areas on his place of enterprise, service or facility all evacuation instructions and directions to be followed by his guests during cyclones, fire, earthquakes, tidal waves and other disasters; and
- (o) the licensee shall display a copy of the licence in a conspicuous area on his place of enterprise, service or facility.
- 6. The licence fees set out in the Fourth Schedule shall be payable to the Board in respect of the various matters therein contained.
- 7. The charges and levies set out in the Fifth Schedule shall be payable to the Board in respect of the various matters therein contained.
- 8. The Minister acting in his discretion may exempt any religious, charitable, benevolent or educational institution or organsiation undertaking, operating, conducting or providing any enterprise, service or facility from the payment of any charges, levies or fees prescribed by these Regulations or may reduce, waive or refund in whole or in part any such charges, levies or fees which would otherwise be payable by any such institution or organisation. The Minister acting in his discretion may exempt in full or may reduce any charges, levies or fees payable by any organisation or individual.
- 9. Levies, charges and fees imposed by these Regulations may be recovered as a civil debt in a court and such proceedings may be commenced and prosecuted by an officer of the Bureau duly authorised in that behalf.
- 10. The licensee shall surrender the licence to the Board within seven days of the occurrence of any of the following -
 - (a) where the licence is cancelled under section 10(1)(b) of the Act; or
 - (b) where the licence is not renewed.
- 11. The Visitors Bureau Regulations 1999 published in the Supplement to the Gazette of Thursday 30th September 1999 as Legal Notice No. 14 & 19 are hereby revoked.
