TRAFFIC ACT (Cap. 131)

THE TRAFFIC (SPEED LIMITS) (NGALIMBIU) ORDER 2003

IN of the powers conferred by section 68 of the Traffic Act, the Local Authority with the approval of the Minister, do hereby make the following order -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic (Speed Limits) (Ngalimbiu) Order 2003.
- 2. In this Order "Ngalimbiu Speed Limit Area" means the area defined in the Second Schedule.
- 3. The classes of motor vehicles specified in the first column of the First Schedule shall observe the speed limits respectively specified in relation thereto in the Second Column thereof within the areas specified in the Third Column thereof.

4. Any person who drives a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of that permitted by paragraph 3 shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of forty dollars or in the case of a second or subsequent conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars.

SECOND SCHEDULE

The Ngalimbiu Speed Limit Area shall comprise all that portion of the road running from Honiara to Tetere which runs from the Ngalimbiu River Bridge for a distance of 2200 metres more or less in an approximately an easterly direction as marked by speed limit notices on the said road and more particularly delineated on Plan No.2139 deposited and available for inspection at the Office of the Commissioner of Lands.

Previous Order is hereby revoked.
