PART 1

INTERPRETATION

- 1. The designation of items as Traditional Artifacts in Part 2 hereto shall be conclusive.
- 2. Any item specifically made for sale as a curio is not a Traditional Artifacts regardless of whether it is so designated in Part 2 hereto.
- 3. The failure to designated any item as a Traditional Artifact in Part 2 hereto shall not operate to exclude said item as a Traditional Artifact is that item is within the definition of a Traditional Artifact contained in Section 2 of the Ordinance.
- 4. "Ordinance" means the Temotu Province Preservation of Culture Ordinance 1989.

5. Those specific items listed in the Schedule hereto are hereby designated as "Traditional Artifacts" pursuant to Section 2 of the Ordinance.
