LABOUR ACT
(Cap. 75)

WORK PERMIT RULES 1985
WORK PERMIT (AMENDMENT) RULES 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 120 of the Labour Act (Cap. 75, the Minister hereby makes the following Rules-

1. These Rules may be cited as the Work Permit (Amendment) Rules 1997.
2. Sub-rule 3 of Rule 7 of the Work Permit Rules (hereinafter referred to as the "principal rules") is hereby amended by deleting the words "two hundred and fifty" thereof and substituting therefor the words "five hundred".
3. The Principal Rules are hereby amended by deleting Schedule 2 thereof and substituting therefor the following schedule -

"SCHEDULE 2**RULES 3 (2)**

Period to be specified	Appropriate Fee
3 months or less	\$150.00
More than 3 months, but not more than 6 months	\$200.00
More than 9 months, but not more than 12 months	\$350.00
More than 12 months, but not more than 15 months	\$650.00
More than 15 months, but not more than 18 months	\$950.00
More than 21 months, but not more than 24 months	\$1,100.00

THE PENSIONS (INCREASE) ACT
(Cap. 111)

THE PENSIONS (INCREASE) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 11A of the Pensions Act, I, MICHAEL MAINA, Minister of Finance, do hereby make the following rules -

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pensions (Increase) (Amendment) Rules 1997.

2. The annual rates of pensions payable to pensionable officers specified in the First and Second Schedules hereto are hereby increased respectively with effect from 1st April 1990 for the following periods -
