IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, MANASSEH SOGAVARE, Minister of Finance, do hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Duties) Amendment) (No.22) Order 1997 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette;
