THE LEADERSHIP CODE (FURTHER PROVISIONS) ACT 1999.

THE LEADERSHIP CODE COMMISSION RULES 2000

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Leadership Code (Further Provisons) Act 1999, the Leadership Code Commission hereby makes the following rules -

Citation and 1. These Rules may be cited as the Leadership Code commencement Commission Rules 2000 and shall come into operation on 4th January 2000.

Classification of cases 2. For the purposes of these Rules, all cases before the Commission shall be classified into three main categories, as follows:-

(a) cases dealing with complaints and allegations of mis-conduct in office by Leaders, made to the Commission by any source whatsoever or which come to its knowledge.

(b) cases relating to failure by Leaders to submit statements or furnish information in terms on Part II of the Act;

(c) cases relating to non-compliance with orders of the Commission.

Preparation of cases and holding of meeting etc. 3. (1) The Secretary shall be responsible for the preparation, in consultation with the Chairman, of cases for consideration by the Commission.

(2) Meeting of the Commission shall be held at such times and places as the Secretary shall specify on the direction of the Chairman.

(3) Where it is so agreed by the members of the Commission that any business of the Commission may be

despatched by circulation of papers, the Secretary shall circulate papers to the members of the Commission who may signify their decision in writing addressed to the Secretary.

The Secretary shall record the minutes of the (4)meetings, including the decision reached by circulation of papers.

4. (1)All cases dealing with complaints or allegations of misconduct in office by Leaders, made to the Commission by any source whatsoever or which come to its knowledge shall, in the first instance, be laid before the Commission under section 23 of the Act for consideration as to whether or not any such cases should be investigated into.

(2)Upon the receipt from an Investigation Officer of a report of his findings on an investigation of any case referred to him under section 23 of the Act, the Commission shall consider the report and decide on the course of action to be taken in accordance with section 24 of the Act.

Where the Commission decides under section (3)24(2) of the Act to refer any case for determination to the High Court, the Legal Officer shall represent the Commission at the proceedings in the High Court.

5. A case relating to a failure by a Leader to submit Disposal of a statement or furnish information in terms of Part II of the Act cases of failure shall be laid before the Commission by the Secretary, together with a summary report on the Leader, for consideration under ment etc. section 23 of the Act. After consideration of the case, the Commission shall decide on the course of action to be taken under section 24 of the Act.

Every case relating to non-compliance with an Disposal of 6. order of the Commission by a person shall be submitted by the Legal Officer, together with a copy of the relevant order, to the Commission for its consideration. Where the Commission deems it necessary that the offender should be dealt with for failing to comply with the order of the Commission, it may decide on the course of action to be followed in accordance with section 28 or 29 of the Act.

THE LEADERSHIP CODE (FURTHER PROVISIONS) **REGULATIONS 2000**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 38 of the Leadership Code (Further Provisions) Act 1999, the Minister, acting on the advice of the Commission, hereby makes the following regulations:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Leadership Citation and Code (Further Provisions) Regulations 2000 and shall come into commencement operation on 4th January 2000.

2. The Prime Minister and the Leader of the (1)Chairman and Opposition shall be the Chairman and Deputy Chairman respec-Deputy Chairman of tively of the Nominating Committee established by section 4 of Nominating the Act. Committee

The quorum of the Committee shall be three (2)members.

3. (1)The Commission may, by instrument in Delegation of writing under the hand of the Chairman, delegate to any officer or employees of the Commission, whether generally or specifically, its power of directing and conducting and investigation of any complaint or allegation of misconduct in office which is Officers made or comes to its knowledge.

(2)Every officer or employees to whom the Commissions' power of investigation is delegated under paragraph (1) (hereinafter referred to as an "Investigating Officer") shall be provided with an identity card bearing the following -

- (a) the name of the officer of employees;
- (b) a recent passport-sized photograph of the holder affixed thereto;

Commission's power of investigation to Investigating

(c) the holder's signature; and

(d) the signature of the Chairman.

(3) An identity card issued to an Investigating Officer under paragraph (3) is the property of the Commission.

(4) Any unauthorized person found in possession of an identity card issued by the Commission under paragraph (2) shall be guilty of an offence under the Penal Code.

(5) Upon the completion of an investigation, an Investigating Officer shall submit to the Commission a report of his findings for its determination.

Statements of assets etc. by Leaders 4. (1) The statement which a Leader is required under the Act to submit to the Commission within three months of his becoming a Leader shall be in Form LC:1 set out in the Schedule hereto.

(2) Every subsequent statement which a Leader is required under the Act to submit to the Commission at intervals not exceeding two years shall be in Form LC:1 set out in the Schedule hereto.

(3) Whenever at any time between the submission of a statement of assets and the date on which the subsequent statement is due, a Leader or his spouse or any of his children acquires any assets or receives any gift, the Leader shall inform the Commission of the acquisition of the assets or the receipt of the gift. The Commission shall thereupon cause the Register of Leaders' Interests to be amended accordingly.

(4) There shall be attached to every LC:1 Form issued by the Commission to Leaders a note containing guideline as to -

(a) the period to be covered by the statements referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2); and

(b) the date and time when the completed forms have to be returned to the Commission; and

any other matters that may help the (c) Leader to fill the form.

All correspondence from the Commission to a (5)Leader in respect of statements on Form LC:1 and matters connected therewith, shall be deemed to be duly received by the Leader if the correspondence is mailed to the last known address of the Leader.

5. An application under section 12(2) of the Act for the written approval of the Commission permitting a Leader or his spouse or any of his children to hold shares, or any other investment or any position or any other financial interest in any company, corporation or any unincorporated association shall be in Form LC:2 set out in the Schedule hereto.

An application by a Leader under section 14(2) of Application by 6. the Act for the written permission of the Commission permitting any corporation or local company in which the Leader of his spouse or any of his children has a controlling interest, to seek, accept or hold any beneficial interest in any contract concluded with the Solomon Islands Government shall be made in Form LC:3 set out in the Schedule.

A complaint made by a person to the Commission 7. under section 23(1) of the Act concerning any alleged or suspected misconduct in office of a Leader shall be in writting, giving the name of the Leader, his occupation, the place where such misconduct in office was committed and the date, if known, where the act of misconduct took place.

Where the Commission proceeds to hold Proceedings of (1)8. an inquiry into a case of alleged misconduct in office against a the Commission Leader whose conduct or affairs had been the subject of investigation, the Commission shall after enumerating the charges made against the Leader, give him sixty days to reply to such charges.

An explanation made by the Leader in reply to the (2)charges made against him under paragraph (1) shall be made to the Commission in writting.

Upon receipt of a reply tendered under paragraph (3) (2), the Commission shall proceed and deliberate on the facts with the evidence, which it has obtained and shall make its determination in accordance with section 24(1) or (2) of the Act.

Evidence before the Commission shall include (4)documents containing written statements on form LC:4 set out in the Schedule hereto.

Leader to permit relevant company to seek interest in any Government contract

Complaints to be in writing

(5) Any witness may be summoned to produce documents without being summoned to give evidence, his personal attendance being dispensed with by the Commission.

(6) A witness having been summoned to appear before the Commission shall be required to answere questions relevant to the inquiry.

Power of entry 9. Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2), (1) a member of the Commission or an Investigating Officer may, at any reasonable time during the day, enter into or upon any land, building or premises over which the Leader who is the subject of an investigation has control or where he conducts his business, for the purposes of carrying out any investigation that is within the jurisdiction of the Commission.

> (2) Before entering into or upon any land, building or premises pursuant to paragraph (1), the member of the Commission or the Investigating Officer shall give at least twenty-four hours notice to the person in charge of the land, building or premises.

10. (1) Whenever, after the submission of the first Leaders to statement under section 8 of the Act a change is made or occurs Commission on in any of the following particulars in respect of a Leader or his change of spouse or any of his children, that is to say addresses etc.

advise

- (a) the home or official address;
- (b) the office or position held;
- (c) marital status; or
- (d) the birth of a child,

the Leader shall, within twenty-eight days of such change, send by registered post or deliver to the Commission a notice in writing specifying the nature and date of the change.

On receipt the notice referred to in paragraph (1), (2)the Commission shall cause to be made such change or deletion in the Register of Leader's Interests.

11. (1) Every summons or notice issued by the Service of sum-Commission under the Act or these Regulations shall be in writing, in duplicate, signed by the Chairman or a Commissioner.

(2) Every summons or notice shall be directed to the person summoned or noticed and shall be served personally on him by an officer of the Commission by delivering or tendering to him at his usual residence or place of work one of the duplicates of the summons or notice.

(3) Where the person summoned or noticed cannot by the exercise of due diligence be found, the summons or notice may be served by leaving one of the duplicates for him with some adult member of his household or with his employer.

(4) A summons to a defendant shall be in Form LC:5, and a summons to a witness shall be in Form LC:6, set out in the Schedule hereto.

THE BANNING AND RESTRICTIONS ON THE SALE OF LIQUOR (HONIARA CITY) ORDER 1999
