THE MINES AND MINERALS ACT (Cap. 42)

THE MINES AND MINERALS (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 1999

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 80 of the Mines and Minerals Act, the Minister of Energy, Mines and Minerals hereby makes the following regulations -

- 1. This Regulation may be cited as the Mines and Minerals (Amendment) Regulation 1999.
- 2. Regulation 68(4) of the Mines and Minerals Regulations* (herebyafter referred to as the "principal Regulation) is hereby amended by deleting the word "caprious" and substituting therefor the word "capricious".
- 3. The principal Regulation is hereby amended by adding therein a second schedule -
