THE MAGISTRATES COURTS (INCREASE OF JURISDICTION) (NO. 2 ORDER 2001)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by section 27(3) of the Magistrates Courts Act, I, SIR (GILBERT) JOHN BAPTIST MURIA, Chief Justice of the High Court of Solomon Islands hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Magistrates Courts (Increased in Criminal Jurisdiction) (No. 2) Order 2001.
- 2. LEONARD R MAINA is hereby invested with jurisdiction to hear and determine any of the offences set out in the Schedule hereto:

1. Any offence under section 226 of the Penal Code.


