(No. 3 of 1998)

FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS (PRESCRIPTION OF FEES) REGULATIONS 2001-01-05

THE MAGISTRATE COURTS (CIVIL PROCEDURES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1999
