PORTS ACT (Cap. 161)

THE LEVY OF RATES AND DUES

(PORTS OF HONIARA AND NORO) RULES 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Ports Act and with the approval of the Minister, the Authority hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2003 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette.
- 2. The rates and dues set out on the Schedule shall be levied by or paid to the Authority in respect of the various matters specified in it, when the works or appliances so specified are provided or the services so specified are performed at the Ports of Honiara and Noro.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything in these Rules it shall be lawful for the Authority to enter into any special agreement in respect of any matter in accordance with the charges specified on the Scheduled of Rates and Dues hereto.
- 4. The levy of Rates and Dues (Ports of Honiara and Noro) Rules 2001 are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE OF DUES AND RATES PORTS OF HONIARA AND NORO

A currency adjustment factor linked to the Central Bank's "basket" of currencies is applied to all charges levied on overseas vessels under PARTS I AND II of the Schedule. The factor applied is advised by public notice from time to time.

Levies shall be calculated in accordance with the weights and measurements appearing in ship's manifest (or amendments thereof) on hundred weights to the nearest hundred weights to the nearest hundred weight or cubic feet or metric tonnes to the nearest twentieth. Whichever produces the greater charge on the basis that one ton shall equal forty cubic feet.
