10. The Attorney General shall be provided with one rent free official vehicle and a fuel allowance of \$500.00 per month.

Leave

11. The Attorney General shall be entitled to leave at the rate of three and half days a month or forty-two days per annum for each year of completed service, which leave shall be taken during the year in which it accrues.

- (1) The Attorney General and members of his family shall be provided with sea or air passages as appropriate to his home village and return passages to Honiara when proceeding on annual leave.
- (2) In this regulation "home village" includes the home village of the spouse.

Compassionate leave 13. The Attorney General shall be entitled to two return trips either by sea or air within Solomon Islands on compassionate leave per annum.

Overseas travel allowance

- (1) The Attorney General shall be entitled to travel first class on all official overseas visits.

Clothing allowance

19. The Attorney General shall be entitled to medical treatment in accordance with the terms prescribed from time to time for public officers.

Personal loan

20. The Attorney General shall be entitled to a Government guaranteed loan, the maximum amount of which shall not exceed his annual basic salary.
