EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021

**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (HONIARA EMERGENCY ZONE)
(RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OF VESSELS) ORDER 2022**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 17 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Vessels) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Definition

In this Order:

“*coast of emergency zone*” means the coastline indicated by the red line from and including point 16 (near Poha Bridge) to and including point 435 (near Alligator Creek Bridge) on the map in Part C of the Schedule, the coordinates for points 16 and 435, and for the coastline between those points, being specified in Part A of the Schedule;

“*emergency zone*” means the emergency zone declared for Honiara by Legal Notice No. 34 of 2020 (as amended by Legal Notice No. 54 of 2020), being the area bounded by a line with the coordinates specified in Part A of the Schedule and indicated by the red line on the map in Part C of the Schedule;

“*essential service*”:

- (a) has the meaning of “essential service” given in section 2(7)(a) of the Essential Services Act (Cap. 12); or
- (b) means any other service the interruption of which could endanger human life, destroy property or cause serious injury to persons or property, including police, correctional services, biosecurity, national disaster and emergency;

“*essential worker*” means:

- (a) a person employed or engaged in carrying out functions, duties or

responsibilities in an essential service; or

- (b) a person who the Prime Minister specifies in writing is an essential worker for the purposes of this Order;

“foreign fishing vessel” has the same meaning as in section 2(1) of the *Fisheries Management Act 2015*;

“foreign vessel” means a vessel that is not registered in Solomon Islands or not entitled to fly the Solomon Islands flag;

“Port of Honiara” means the Port of Honiara declared under section 5 of the *Ports Act* (Cap. 161), the limits of which are declared under that section in the *Declaration of Ports Limits* (Cap. 161) and demarcated by a line that has the coordinates specified in Part B of the Schedule and shown bounded by a blue line on the map in Part C of the Schedule;

“vessel” does not include a foreign vessel that is not a foreign fishing vessel;

“wharf” means a wharf that is located within the Port of Honiara or anywhere else on the coast of the emergency zone.

4 Restriction of movement of vessels

- (1) On and from 6.00 pm on Wednesday 19 January 2022 until 6.00 am on Saturday 22 January 2022, a vessel must not:
- (a) enter or leave the Port of Honiara; or
 - (b) come along side or berth at a wharf; or
 - (c) go on shore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone.
- (2) On and from 6.00 pm on Wednesday 19 January 2022 until 6.00 am on Saturday 22 January 2022, the operator of a vessel must not, permit or enable any person on board the vessel to disembark from the vessel and go ashore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone.

5 Exemptions, etc

- (1) An authorised officer is exempted from complying with this Order while carrying out his or her functions, responsibilities or duties as an authorised officer, or travelling to and from the place where he or she carries out those functions, responsibilities or duties.
- (2) An essential worker is exempted from complying with this Order while carrying out his or her work functions, responsibilities or duties, or travelling to and from his or her place of work.
- (3) Paragraph 4 does not apply to a vessel operated by an authorised officer or an essential worker while performing his or her functions, responsibilities or duties.
