Practice Direction No. 2 of 1994

<u>Taxation of Costs at Magistrates' and Chief Police</u> <u>Magistrate's Courts</u>

1. In all bills of costs taxed in the Magistrates' Courts and the Chief Police Magistrate's Court the following rates shall be allowable for law practitioners.

Magistrates Courts - one third of the rate allowable in the Supreme Court.

<u>Chief Police Magistrate</u> - two thirds of the rate allowable in the Supreme Court.

The rates in the Supreme Court at the date of this direction are as stated in Practice Direction No. 2 of 1992.

2. Wherever good cause is shown the Magistrate may increase the amount allowable in his discretion and must state the ground for his decision.
