AN ACT

TO LEGALISE CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE IN THE YEAR 1987-88 IN EXCESS OF EXPENDITURE SANTIONED BY THE 1987-88 DEVELOPMENT FUND APPROPRIATION ACT 1987.

[19th September 1989.]

BE IT ENACTED by the King and Legislative Assembly of Tonga in the Legislature of the Kingdom as follows:

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as The 1987-88 Development Fund Supplementary Appropriation Act 1989.
2. The sum of money set forth in the schedule hereto having been expended for the services therein mentioned beyond the amounts granted for these services by the Act passed for making provision for the expenditure of the Kingdom for the year ended the thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and eighty eight the same are hereby declared to have been duly and necessarily paid, laid out and expended for the services of the Kingdom in that year and are hereby approved, allowed and granted in addition to the amounts mention for these services in the Act aforesaid.

Passed in the Legislative Assembly this 19th day of September, 1989.

2. The 1987-88 Development Fund Supplementary Appropriation Act 1989 - 13 of 1989.

The main reasons for the over-expended votes are as follows:

Vote 44 - Police and Prisons \$76,495

Overspending was caused by the establishment of the new Prison Farm on 'Eua. This project was funded by a Special Warrant (\$80,000).

Vote 56 - Miscellaneous - Social and Community Services \$157,398

The main reasons for the over-expenditure were the construction of a new building for the TBC's new transmitter (\$107,388) and assistance given for upgrading the Non-Government Education System (\$50,000). These were funded by aid and Special Warrants were approved.

Vote 63(b) - Tourism \$869,417

The over-expenditure in this vote resulted from further development of the Tonga National Centre (\$214,800) and the upgrading of the Dateline Hotel (\$657,316). Special Warrants amounting to \$1,200,000 were approved to cover these expenditure.

Vote 73 - Civil Aviation \$30,987

The excess was caused by expenditure on National Airline Phase II (\$200,000). This was approved by Special Warrant. This was offset by under-expenditure on other projects, namely Fua'amotu Airport (\$101,221), Power cables for Lupepau'u Airport (\$8,000), Road diversion for Salote Pilolevu Airport (\$10,000) and Hangar, Fua'amotu (\$49,761).

Vahe 44 - Polisi mo e 'Api Popula \$76,495

Na'e tupu 'a e hulu ko 'eni 'a e fakamole mei he fokotu'u 'o e Faama 'Api Popula 'i 'Eua. Na'e fakapa'anga 'a e ngaue ni 'aki ha mafai Toho Pa'anga Makehe (\$80,000).

Vahe 56 - Me'a Kehekehe - Fakasosine mo e Fakakolo \$157,398

Ko e ongo 'uhinga lalahi ki he hulu ange 'a e fakamole, ko e langa 'o e fale fo'ou ki he misini tulenisimita 'a e Komisoni Fakamafola Lea Tonga (\$107,388) pea mo e tokoni ki he fakaleci'i 'o e Ngaahi Ako 'Ikai Faka-Pule'anga (\$50,000). Na'e fakapa'anga 'eni 'e he tokoni 'ofa pea tali mo e ongo kole mafai toho pa'anga makehe.

Vahe 63(b) - Takimamata mo e Folau 'Eve'eva \$869,417

Na'e tupu 'a e hulu 'a e fakamole mei he toe fakaleci'i 'o e Senita Fakafonua 'o Tonga (\$214,800) pea mo e fakaleci'i 'o e Hotele Teitilaine (\$657,316). Na'e tali e mafai toho pa'anga makehe fe'unga mo e \$1,200,000 ke huhu'i e ngaahi fakamole ko 'eni.

Vahe 73 - Folau Vakapuna Sivile \$30,987

Ko e hulu 'o e fakamole ko 'eni ko e tupu mei he fakamole ki he Konga II Kautaha Vakapuna Fakafonua (\$200,000). Na'e tali ha mafai toho pa'anga makehe ke fai'aki e ngaue ni. Na'e fetamate'aki e hulu ko 'eni mo e ngaahi ngaue na'e si'isi'i hono ngaue'aki honau pa'anga 'o hange ko e Mala'e Vakapuna Salote Pitolevu (\$10,000) pea mo e Fale Tau'anga Vakapuna, Fua'amotu (\$49,761).
