CUSTOMS DUTY (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) ORDER 2020

CUSTOMS ACT 2007

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Customs Act 2007, the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order -

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs Duty (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2020.
- (2) The Customs Duty Order 2008, as amended, imposing customs duty on goods effective from 1 February 2008 and published in the Government Gazette Supplement Extraordinary on 21 January 2008 shall be referred to as the "Principal Order".
- (3) This Order shall come into force on 1 July 2020.
- (4) Chapter 2 of the Principal Order is amended by
 - (a) replacing the words "Free but see excise schedule" with the word "Free" in the Import Duty Rate columns for the following tariff items -

(b) inserting the following new tariff items, description, Unit Qty, Import Duty Rate and Export Duty in their appropriate section and numerical order –

0204.42.30	Mutton breast	kg	Free but see excise schedule	Free

(5) Chapter 24 of the Principal Order is amended by –

(a) inserting the following new tariff items in their appropriate section and numerical order –

2402.20.11	Cigarettes manufactured locally from locally grown tobacco (Tapaka Tonga)	kg	Free but see excise schedule	Free
2402.20.19	Cigarettes manufactured locally from imported tobacco	kg	Free but see excise schedule	Free
