CONSUMPTION TAX ORDER 2011

CONSUMPTION TAX ACT 2003

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act 2003, the Chief Commissioner of Revenue, with the consent of Cabinet, makes the following Order:

- 1 The following imports shall be exempt from Consumption Tax
 - (a) herbicides for use in agriculture;
 - (b) live horses, asses, mules and hinnes, and
 - (c) live sheep and goats.
- 2 The following taxable supplies shall be subject to a zero rate of Consumption Tax
 - (a) herbicides for use in agriculture;
 - (b) live horses, asses, mules and hinnes, and
 - (c) live sheep and goats.
