## PASSPORT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2011

#### PASSPORT ACT

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Passport Act, the Minister of Foreign Affairs with the consent of Cabinet makes the following Regulations:

#### 1 Short Title

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Passport (Amendment) Regulations 2011.
- (2) The Passport Regulations are referred to in these Regulations, as the Principal Regulations.

#### 2 Schedule II replaced

Schedule II of the Principal Regulations is repealed and replaced with the following -
