## AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENTING THE ANGLO-FRENCH

## PROTOCOL RESPECTING THE NEW HEBRIDES OF THE

## 6th AUGUST 1914

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED pursuant to section 14 of the New Hebrides Order 1973 at upon publication hereof the Protocol made the 6th day of August 1914 between e Government of His Late Majesty King George the Fifth and the Government of the ench Republic in the terms set forth in the Schedule to the New Hebrides Order Council 1922 as interpreted in accordance with the agreement to that effect ntained in the notes exchanged between the two Governments dated the 16th day December 1922 and the 26th day of December 1922 respectively, and set out in the medule to the New Hebrides Order in Council 1922 as interpreted in accordance th the agreement to that effect contained in the notes exchanged between the o Governments dated the 16th day of December 1922 and the 26th day of December 22 respectively, and set out in the Schedule to the New Hebrides Order in uncil 1923 and as modified, added to, or amended by any of the agreements set t in the Schedule to the New Hebrides Order in Council 1963 and by the ovisions of section 4 of the New Hebrides Order in Council 1970, and as modified, ded to or amended by the agreements constituted by the Exchanges of Notes tween the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern eland and the Government of the French Republic dated the 2nd day of September 70, the 10th day of February 1972, the 19th day of April 1972, the 21st day of My 1972, the 11th day of April 1973, the 10th day of May 1973, the 17th day of 7 1974 and the 29th day of August 1975, shall have the force of law and shall binding upon all such persons as are referred to in section 2 of the New brides Order in Council 1922, subject to the agreement constituted by the change of Notes between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain Northern Ireland and the Government of the French Republic dated at London the th day of November 1975, providing that the Agreement constituted by the Exchange Notes of 29th August 1975 concerning the establishment of a Representative sembly in the New Hebrides shall be construed, as from the date of its entry to force, in the following manner:

- (a) In Article 3, paragraph (1) (a) of the Schedule, the term "temporary absences" shall be read as excluding holidays and business visits, provided that such absences (together with any other absences) do not exceed twelve months in the aggregate; and
- (b) In Article 5 of the Schedule the words "the appropriate electoral roll" shall be read as referring to any of the electoral rolls mentioned in Article 3 of the Schedule.
