## QUEEN'S REGULATION

TO AMEND the Education (School Boards of Management) Regulation 1974.

MADE BY Her Britannic Majesty's Resident Commissioner in the New Hebrides in pursuance of the powers contained in the New Hebrides Orders. In the name of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Education (School Boards of Management) (Amendment) Regulation 1976 and shall come into operation on the date on which it is published by the Resident Commissioner causing a copy thereof to be exhibited at the Public Office of the Resident Commissioner.
2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Education (School Boards of Management) Regulation 1974 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulation") is hereby amended by deleting the words "add to" and replacing them by the word "amend".
3. The principal Regulation is hereby further amended by adding immediately after section 14 the following new section -

"Dissolution  
of Boards

15. A Board established under section 3 may be dissolved by order of the Resident Commissioner, who shall by such order make provision for its liquidation or the succession to its assets and liabilities, as the case may be.
