JOINT REGULATION 5 of 1968

JOINT REGULATION

No. 5 of
1968.

To bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1968.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 267.]

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of the Joint Finance Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after Consultation with the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Majesty and of the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1968 Appropriation Joint Regulation.
2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration of the year 1968 shall provide for—
 - (a) Revenue for the amount of One Million Two Hundred and Eighty-Three Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-Eight pounds sterling (£Stg. 1,283,168) or Two Hundred and Seventy-Five Million Eight Hundred and Eighty Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty-Five New Hebrides francs (275,880,625 FNH).
 - (b) Expenditure to the amount of One Million, Three Hundred and One Thousand, Five Hundred and Forty pounds sterling (£Stg. 1,301,540) or Two Hundred and Seventy-Nine Million Eight Hundred and Thirty-One Thousand and Eighty-Five New Hebrides francs (279,831,085 FNH).
3. There shall be issued from General Revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the service of the year ending 31st December, 1968 a sum not exceeding that specified in subsection (b) of section 2 of this Regulation. The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedule to this Regulation.
4. The Resident Commissioners may jointly authorise the Ordonnateur and the Condominium Treasurer to control expenditure each according to his responsibilities as set out in Joint Standing Order No. 4 of 1957 within the limits fixed by such authorisation;

such sums shall not exceed on the whole the sum specified in subsection (b) of Section 2 of this Regulation.
