JOINT REGULATION

No. 40
of 1973.

To establish charges for services rendered by the Agricultural Department to private individuals.

[Published: Special Edition, Condominium Gazette.]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 2 (2) and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Any official service rendered to private individuals by officers of the Agricultural Department shall be paid for in accordance with the charges set out in the Schedule to this Regulation.
2. All charges levied by the Agricultural Department as aforesaid shall require the issue of a receipt and shall be paid to the Condominium Treasury.
3. No certificate specified in the Schedule shall be issued before full payment of the appropriate fee.
4. This Regulation shall be cited as Joint Agricultural Fees Regulation No. 40 of 1973 and shall come into effect on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.

SCHEDULE

TARIFF OF FEES TO BE PAID FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT TO PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS

Payment of the fees listed below in FNH may be made in Australian Dollars at the official rate of exchange obtaining at the date of payment.

	New Hebrides Francs
I.— <i>The Establishment of Phytosanitary Certificates—</i>	
(i) Ordinary certificate, after fumigation of a small object sent in by its owner	50
(ii) Certificate drawn up after fumigation has been carried out at the home of the owner	200
(iii) Certificate drawn up after fumigation of an object brought into the territory without a certificate from the country from which it has come, and taken by the authorities at the port or airport	1000

II.—*The Establishment of Zoo Sanitary Certificates—*

(i) Certificate drawn up after examination has been conducted at the Department's veterinary clinic	150
(ii) Certificate drawn up after the animal has been visited at the domicile of its owner	250
(iii) Health certificate for products of animal origin	50

III.—*Veterinary Clinic for Pets—*

(i) Ordinary visit	200
(ii) Medical vaccination and injection (the vaccination and medicine supplied or paid for the owner)	100
(iii) Minor medical treatment and dressings	500
(iv) Major medical treatment upon prior agreement	

Note (i) The veterinary clinic rates shall be doubled in the event of visits made and treatment given on Saturdays, Sundays or Public Holidays or outside normal working hours.

(ii) Treatment remains free for cattle (cows, horses, pigs, etc. . . .).
