Issued by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of rticle 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. In this Regulation and in any Orders made thereunder Interpretalicence" means a licence granted under the provisions of this tion. legulation and "licensee" means a person holding a licence which as not expired and has not been revoked.

2. The Resident Commissioners may by Order jointly declare ny islands, island or part of an island to be a closed district.

- 3. No person shall enter or remain in a closed district except-
- (a) Natives of the closed district;
- (b) Other natives or classes of natives who may be exempted by order of the Resident Commissioners;
- (c) Government officers and persons acting under the orders of the Resident Commissioners in the course of their duty;
- (d) Licensees.

ent ler 4. (1) For such period as they may jointly determine the Resident Commissioners may grant or renew a licence to enter a closed district and may if they think fit prescribe conditions (which thall be endorsed upon the licence) upon which such licence is traited or renewed and may also as a condition precedent to the trant or renewal of a licence require the proposed licensee to furnish security either in cash or by bond for the observance of the conditions, which amount shall also be endorsed on the licence.

(2) Subject to the provisions of Articles 6, 7 and 8 hereof, the ecurity furnished by any licensee shall be returned to him on the upity, non-renewal or revocation of any licence issued under this Regulation.

5. (1) The Resident Commissioners may at any time revoke licence.

(2) Notice of revocation shall be given in writing to the licensee and shall be served personally or by registered post.

(3) Such revocation shall take effect from the date of receipt such notice by the licensee or from such later date as the Resident commissioners may by such notice prescribe.
