JOINT REGULATION 12 of 1941

## A JOINT REGULATION

No. 12 of 1941.

Interpretation.

Power to
declare
closed
district.
Entry into
closed
district prohibited.

Licence to enter closed district. Resident Commissioners may grant or renew a licence to enter a closed district and may if they think fit prescribe conditions (which Thall be endorsed upon the licence) upon which such licence is granted or renewed and may also as a condition precedent to the grant or renewal of a licence require the proposed licensee to Gurnish security either in cash or by bond for the observance of the conditions, which amount shall also be endorsed on the licence.
(2) Subject to the provisions of Articles 6, 7 and 8 hereof, the fecurity furnished by any licensee shall be returned to him on the Expiry, non-renewal or revocation of any licence issued under this Regulation.
5. (1) The Resident Commissioners may at any time revoke licence.
(2) Notice of revocation shall be given in writing to the licensee ind shall be served personally or by registered post.
(3) Such revocation shall take effect from the date of receipt fish notice by the licensee or from such later date as the Resident ommissioners may by such notice prescribe.
6. Subject to the provisions of Article 3 hereof any person tering or being in a closed district without a licence or remaining a closed district after the expiry or revocation of his licence shall guilty of an offence and in addition to any other penalty shall be sble to repay to the Resident Commissioners any expenses entailed pon the Condominium Government by any action taken in connexwith such offence.
7. If a licensee commits a breach of the conditions endorsed pon his licence or does any act calculated to disturb the peace of a losed district or to cause the natives of that district to be disaffected opwards the Government he shall be guilty of an offence and in oddition to any other penalty shall be liable to forfeit any security urnished by him.
8. The Resident Commissioners may recover from the licensee ay expenditure incurred by the Condominium Government in endering him assistance and shall be entitled to recover the amount If such expenditure out of any security furnished by him.
9. In addition to the forfeiture of security as provided by Grticle 7 hereof, a person guilty of an offence under this Regulation or any Orders made thereunder shall be liable on conviction to pay a gine not exceeding twenty pounds and imprisonment not exceeding Sne month or one or other of these penalties.
10. This Regulation may be cited as the Closed Districts Soint Regulation No. 12 of 1941 and shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
