A JOINT REGULATION

provide for the compulsory medical treatment of natives.

Issued by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of
Article 3 of Article 8 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Any District Agent may, on the advice of a Condominium
Medical Officer, require any native or body of natives to undergo a
medical treatment under the control of a Condominium
Medical Officer or Native Medical Practitioner and any native
obeying any of the provisions of such an Order shall be deemed
to have committed an offence against this Regulation.

2. This Regulation shall have effect in any area where a
Native Court has jurisdiction.

3. Breaches of this Regulation shall be punishable by a fine
not exceeding £5 and imprisonment not exceeding one month or by
one or other of these penalties.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the New Hebrides Native
(Medical Protection) Regulation No. 11 of 1941 and shall come into
force on the day of the date hereof.
