JOINT REGULATION 2 of 1966

JOINT REGULATION

No. 2 of 1966.

To prohibit the discharge of firearms within the town limits of Vila and Santo.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

[1. No person, other than members of the New Hebrides Constabulary, officers of the Condominium Agricultural Department or such other persons or classes of persons as the Resident Commissioners may by Joint Decision authorise in that behalf subject to any restrictions or conditions they may by such Joint Decision impose; shall within the areas delineated on the plans deposited at the District Agencies for Central District No. 1 and Northern District discharge any firearm.]

Prohibition of discharge of firearms. Amended by J.R. No. 1 of 1971.

2. For a period of three months from the coming into operation of this Regulation the said plans shall be exhibited on the official town notice boards of Vila and Santo.

Exhibition of Plans.

3. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of Section 1 of this Regulation shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £50 or its equivalent in francs at the current rate of exchange or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalties.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Prohibition of Firearms Regulation No. 2 of 1966 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
