JOINT REGULATION

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. In this Regulation, the Exchange of Letters bearing dates the 6th March, 1972 and the 17th March, 1972 between Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom on the one hand and the British and French Resident Commissioners in the New Hebrides on the other for a loan of £ Stg. 300,000 to finance the construction of the Vila Wharf is referred to as "the Loan Agreement".

Interpreta-

2. The principal moneys borrowed by the British and French Resident Commissioners from Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom under the provisions of the Loan Agreement shall be appropriated and applied to the construction of a wharf and auxiliary buildings and installation buildings and installation at Vila.

Application of loan moneys.

3. The principal moneys borrowed under the Loan Agreement and the interest thereon are hereby charged upon the general revenues and assets of the Joint Administration.

Repayment charged on revenues and assets of Joint Administration.

- 4. So long as any principal moneys due under the Loan Agreement remain outstanding, the Resident Commissioners shall—
 - (a) cause to be included in the annual estimates of revenue and expenditure of the Joint Administration prepared pursuant to the provisions of the Joint Finance Regulation, 1957, an item of expenditure amounting to two half-yearly instalments of repayment of principal and interest to Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom as provided by the Loan Agreement; and
 - (b) in each half-year appropriate out of the revenues and assets of the Joint Administration a sum equal to one half-yearly instalment of repayment of principal and interest as provided by the Loan Agreement and shall remit that sum to Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom so that it is received on or before the date on which it falls due under the Loan Agreement.

Resident Commissioners to include instalments in annual estimates and to appropriate and pay instalments. 5. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Vila Wharf Loan (Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom) Regulation No. 11 of 1972 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.

Citation and commencement.

Made at Vila this twentieth day of April, 1972.
