Proviso added to s.3(2) of J.R. No. 20 of 1975

Amendment of s. 7 of principal Regulation

TO AMEND the Joint Electoral (Proxy Voting) Regulation No. 20 of 1975 as amended.

MADE by the Resident Comissioners under the 'provisions of Articles $2: 2$ and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Joint Electoral (Proxy Voting) Regulation No. 20 of 1975 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulation") is hereby amended by substituting a colon for the fullstop at the end thereof and by adding thereafter the following proviso -
"Provided that in the case of central government elections in any rural constituency the proxy may be registered on any electoral roll in such constituency.".
2. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 7 of the principal Regulation are hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsections -
" (2) If more than two proxies are made out in favour of the same elector, only the two earliest by date shall be valid. If more than two proxies are made out in favour of the same elector on the same date, the presiding officer of the polling station shall require the person holding the proxies to elect between them.
(3) In any case where any proxy is invalid or rendered invalid by reason of the foregoing provisions of this section, the presiding officer shall take such steps as may be available, if any, to notify the elector who gave the proxy of its invalidity.".
3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Electoral (Proxy Voting) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulation No. 41 of 1975 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
