NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 17 of 1976

TO PROVIDE for the temporary control of the importation of fresh vegetables.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Togulate importation of vegetables

1. The Resident Commissioners may by joint decision prohibit the importation of any fresh vegetables for consumption in any part or parts of the New Hebrides.

Suspension of prohibition or restriction 2. The Resident Commissioners may by joint decision suspend for any period the operation of any joint decision made under the provisions of section 1.

Offences

3. Any person who shall contravene the provisions of any joint decision made under the provisions of section 1 shall commit an offence punishable upon conviction by a fine not exceeding 10,000FNH or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange;

Provided that no prosecution shall be commenced against any person under this section who has entered into a binding agreement with an overseas supplier for the consignment of any fresh vegetables to the New Hebrides prior to the commencement or the revival of any prohibition or restriction imposed under the provisions of this Regulation.

Citation and commencement

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Import Control (Fresh Vegetables) Regulation No. 17 of 1976 and upon its publication in the Condominium Gazette shall come into operation until the 31st day of December 1976.
