

TO PROVIDE for the placing of officers in the Joint Administration under the authority of the Chief Minister, and matters connected therewith.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 as amended by the Exchange of Notes of the fifteenth day of September, 1977 for the further and better carrying into effect of the Council of Ministers Regulation, 1978.

Officers of Joint Administration under authority of Chief Minister.

1. (1) Subject to section 2, all officers employed by the Resident Commissioners for the service of the Joint Administration of the Condominium, are hereby placed under the authority of the Chief Minister who by reason thereof shall succeed to the Resident Commissioners in all their rights and obligations.

(2) In this section "Officer" includes every person employed by the Resident Commissioners for the service of the Condominium Joint Administration, irrespective of the terms of service under which he is so employed.

Section 1 without prejudice to future of Public Service et cetera.

2. Nothing in section 1 shall prejudice the future of the Public Service in the New Hebrides or affect any arrangements to be made for the winding up of the service of the Joint Administration of the Condominium.

Short Title and commencement.

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Administration (Transfer of Staff) Regulation, 1978, and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
