1. The Joint Liquor Licensing Regulation No. 18 of 1968 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 14 the following new section

"Power of Resident Commissioners to close licensed premises 14A. The Resident Commissioners may in the interest of
public peace and good order by
Joint Decision prohibit the
sale of liquor in or from
licenced premises or any class
or type thereof in the New
Hebrides or any place or places
therein for a period not
exceeding three days. ".

Citation and commence-ment

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Regulation No. 19 of 1975 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
