JOINT REGULATION

No. 10 of 1978

TO PUT INTO EFFECT the Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 8 of 1978, passed the 28th day of July 1978, to amend the New Hebrides Dwelling House Construction and Town Conservancy Regulation No. 6 of 1931.

<u>MADE</u> by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Article 28 (3) of the Exchange of Notes made at London the fifteenth day of September 1977 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the French Republic.

Scheduled 1. The Resolution of the Representative Assembly Resolution No. 8 of 1978, set forth in the Schedule, is hereby put into put into effect.

Short title 2. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the New and Hebrides Dwelling House and Town Conservancy (Amendment) commencement Regulation 1978 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the New Hebrides Government Gazette.

RESOLUTION NO.8 OF 1978

relating to the amendment of Section 16 of the New Hebrides Dwelling House Construction and Town Conservancy Regulation No. 6 of 1931.

The Representative Assembly of the New Hebrides, at its sitting on the 28th day of July, 1978 hereby resolves and decides, in accordance with Articles 23 and 25 of the Exchange of Notes of the fifteenth day of September 1977, to adopt the following measures -

"1. Section 16 of the New Hebrides Dwelling House Construction and Town Conservancy Regulation No. 6 of 1931 is amended by deleting the words from "penalties not exceeding" to the end of the section and replacing them by: "a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand New Hebrides francs (FNH 100.000)."
