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NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 29 of 1974

TO AMEND the Joint Taxis Regulation No. 36 of 1966 (as amended).

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Section 6 of the Joint Taxis Regulation No. 36 of 1966 as amended, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulation) is hereby amended by deleting the word "and" where it appears at the end of paragraph (c) of subsection (1), by deleting the full stop at the end of paragraph (d) and replacing it with a semi-colon followed by the word "and" and by adding the following new paragraph -

> "(e) That where the said vehicle is a taxi it is equipped with a taxi-meter of a type approved by the Resident Commissioners which is visible from outside the vehicle and which indicates at all times the amount due to be paid in respect of the journey then being undertaken. ".

2. Section 15A of the principal Regulation is hereby amended by deleting the word "and" where it appears at the end of paragraph (a), by deleting the full stop at the end of paragraph (b) and by replacing it with a semi-colon followed by the word "and" and by adding the following new paragraph -

> "(c) Where such a vehicle is a taxi, it is equipped with a taxi-meter in working order as required by the provisions of section 6 (1) (e) . ".

3. Schedule 8 of the principal Regulation is hereby amended by deleting the second part thereof (relating to fires on the Island of Espiritu Santo) and replacing it with the Schedule hereto.

4. (1) Sections 1 and 2 of this Regulation shall be applied on the island of Vate from the first day of January 1975 and may thereafter be applied by joint decision of the Resident Commissioners to such other areas in the New Hebrides as they may think fit.
