JOINT REGULATION

No. 55 of 1976

TO ENABLE authorised persons to enter on private land for the purpose of preparing valuation lists.

MADE BY the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. It shall be lawful for members of the Condominium Survey Department who have been authorised in writing by the Resident Commissioners and such other persons as have been authorised by Joint Decision of the Resident Commissioners to enter upon any land or premises in Vila and Santo for the purpose of preparing valuation lists of properties in the municipalities of Vila and Santo.

2. Before any authorised person enters upon any land or premises in accordance with the provisions of the foregoing section a notice of his intention to do so shall be served on the occupier of the land or premises at least seven working days before such entry be effected.

3. Any person who shall assault, molest or wilfully hinder or obstruct any person authorised to enter land and premises in accordance with section 1 shall commit an offence punishable upon conviction by a fine not exceeding 20,000 FNH or its equivalent in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Valuation (Entry on Premises) Regulation No. 550 f 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
