Chapter 20

THE PRISONERS (RELEASE ON LICENCE) ORDER No. 7 OF 1997

An Order to provide for the release of Prisoner LEAH TURELEO.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Prisons (Administration) Act [CAP. 20], I, ROBERT DAVID KARIE, Minister of Home Affairs and Minister responsible for prisons, HEREBY MAKE the following Order:-

RELEASE OF PRISONER ON LICENCE

1. **LEAH TURELEO** who is currently being held in custody as a prisoner, shall be set free and released from prison on the 21st day of February, 1997 **SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS** set out in sections 2 and 3 of this Order.

TERMS AD CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

- The following terms and conditions shall apply -
 - (a) LEAH TURELEO shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour for a period commencing on the day of her release being 21st day of February, 1997 and ending on the 10th day of January, 1998, which period is hereinafter called "the relevant period".
 - (b) In the event that **LEAH TURELEO** should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period, whether or not the offence is of a similar nature as that for which **LEAH TURELEO**'s original prison sentence was order by the Court or, the Court before which **LEAH TURELEO** appears for such new offence orders a prison sentence, **LEAH TURELEO** shall automatically be recalled and returned to prison.

PROCEDURES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CONDITIONS OR RELEASE, RECALL TO PRISON, ETC.

- 3. In every case where the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 2 apply, the following procedures shall apply:
 - (a) Where the Minister is satisfied that **LEAH TURELEO** has violated the terms and conditions set out in section 2, the Minister shall issue a Notice in writing directing that **LEAH TURELEO** is returned to custody forthwith.
 - (b) A Notice issued by the Minister shall be served on **LEAH TURELEO** directing her to return to prison at such time and on such day as specified in the Notice.
 - (c) **LEAH TURELEO** when returned to prison in accordance with this section shall be obliged to serve the unexpired term of her original sentence which she would have had to serve if she has not been released in accordance with this Order.
 - (d) **LEAH TURELEO** when returned to prison in accordance with this section is not entitled to have part of her original unexpired term of sentence remitted.

COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF PRISONS TO ENFORCE DIRECTIONS OF THE MINISTER

4. The Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Prisons shall take all lawful measures required or necessary to enforce every direction or notice issued by the Minister under this Order.

COMMENCEMENT

5. This Order shall come into force on the 21st day of February, 1997.
