## REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (PEOPLEITION OF SALE OF LIQUOR) ORDER NO. 69 OF 1983

To restrict the sale of liquor during polling day of the November 2nd 1983 general elections.

IN EXERCISE of the power contained in section 65(1)(b) of the Representation of the People Act No. 13 of 1982, THE ELECTORAL COMMISSION NEWERY MAKES the following Order:

## SALE OF LIQUOR RESTRICTED

- (a) All sale or supply of alcoholic liquor in the Republic shall be prohibited at or by all licensed premises or persons including clubs from the midday of Tuesday November 1st to the midnight of Wednesday November 2nd 1983.
  - (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the sale and supply of alcoholic liquor shall be permitted in licensed restaurants to customers consuming a meal therein.

## COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall come into force on the date of its signature.
