

# REPUBLIC OF VANUATU ROAD TRAFFIC [CONTROL] ACT [CAP 29]

## COMPOUNDING FINE REGULATION

## Order No 20 of 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 46A (2), 53 (1) and 59 (b) of the Road Traffic (Control) Act [CAP 29], I, the Honorable James BULE, Acting Minister of Finance and Economic Management, make the following order.

## 1 Interpretation

Act means the Road Traffic (Control) Act [CAP 29].

## 2 Driving Licence that has no expiry date

- (1) A holder of a driving licence that has no expiry date must present his or her licence to the licensing authority, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2007 to be issued with a new driving licence that has a validity of 3 years.
- (2) A person who fails to comply with clause 2 is liable to pay a compound fine of VT 2,500.

## 3 Renewal of a Driving Licence that has an expiry date

A holder of a driving licence who has not renewed his or her driver's licence on or before the expiry of that licence is liable to pay a fine of VT 2,500.

### 4 Compounding Notice

A person referred to in clause 2 and 3 will be issued with a compounding notice once a police officer of the rank of inspector or above establishes the contravention.

### 5 Time of payment

The person referred to in clause 2 and 3 must pay the compounding fine within 2 days from the date on which he or she is served with the compounding notice.

#### 6 Commencement

This Order commences on the date on which it is published in the Gazette.
