



THE CIVIL AVIATION (AIRCRAFT SPECIAL NIGHT LANDING  
AND TAKE OFF FEES REGULATION) (AMENDMENT) NO.1)  
ORDER NO. 37 OF 1985

To amend the Civil Aviation (Aircraft Special Night Landing and Take Off Fees Regulation) Order No.44 of 1984.

**IN EXERCISE** of the power contained in section 3 (1) (r) of the Civil Aviation Act No.38 of 1982 **I HEREBY MAKE** the following Order:-

**AMENDMENT OF ORDER NO.44 OF 1984**

1. The Civil Aviation (Aircraft Special Night Landing and Take Off Fees Regulation) Order No.44 of 1984 is amended as follows:

(a) By repealing section 4 and substituting the following therefor -

**"METHOD OF PAYMENT**

4 (a) The fees herein provided shall become due immediately after the arrival and or prior to the departure of the aircraft and shall, subject to the provisions of sub-paragraph (b) be payable on behalf of the owner or charterer by the Captain of the aircraft to an authorized officer of the Government at each airport.

(b) The fees may by prior arrangement be paid to the Department of Civil Aviation by the airline on a quarterly basis in respect of movements (landing and take off) made by the airline during the previous three months.

(c) Where the fees are not paid by the airline within 30 days of the due date the Government shall recover the amount due as a civil debt".

**COMMENCEMENT**

2. This Order shall come into force on the first day of October, 1985.



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As indicated in Note 2, certain customers, at their request, are not the subject of the standard procedure whereby statements of account are mailed on a regular basis. In addition, because of bank policy, we have not been able to verify by direct confirmation some customers' deposit balances, or carry out alternative audit procedures.

The total of the customers deposits which have not been verified is US\$1,052,651.

We have audited the attached accounts in accordance with currently accepted auditing standards.

In our opinion, except for any adjustments that might have been necessary had we been able to obtain direct confirmation of customers deposit balances or carry out alternative procedures:

- (a) the accounts of Bank Gutzwiller, Kurz, Bungener (Overseas) Limited, and group accounts are in agreement with the books and records of the Company and are properly drawn up in accordance with the Companies Regulation (Cap.9) and the Banking Regulation (Cap.8) and so as to give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company and of the group as at 28th February, 1985 and of the result of the company and of the group for the year ended on that date so far as they concern members of the holding company and are in accordance with applicable approved accounting standards.
- (b) the accounting records and other records, and the registers required by the Companies Regulation (Cap.9) and the Banking Regulation (Cap.8) to be kept by the Company have been properly kept in accordance with provisions of those regulations or in the case of the subsidiary in accordance with the provisions of the corresponding law of the Cayman Islands.

1. Principal Accounting Methods

- (a) The accounts are based on historical cost and therefore do not reflect changes in the purchasing power of money or current valuation of non-monetary assets except where otherwise indicated.
- (b) Foreign currency transactions throughout the year have been converted at exchange rates ruling on transaction dates. Share Capital has been converted from Australian Dollars to United States Dollars at exchange rate ruling at date of issue. Foreign currency balance sheet items have been converted to United States Dollars at exchange rates ruling at February 28, 1985.
- (c) Depreciation: Fixed Assets are depreciated over their estimated useful lives using the straight line method.
- (d) Trust Transactions: One of the companies in the group acts as a trustee. The accounting policies adopted by the company in the preparation of the accounts for the year ended 28 February, 1985 do not reflect the fiduciary nature of the company's responsibility for the assets and liabilities of the trusts.

2. Customers' Deposits

Customers' deposits include balances on certain accounts which at the request of customers do not require the periodic dispatch to these customers of statements of account. Management is satisfied that the internal control procedures operating in respect of these accounts are adequate.
