ORDER No 30... OF 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 (1) of the Commissions of Inquiry Act (CAP 85), I, Honorable Serge Rialuth Vohor, Prime Minister and Minister responsible for Justice, make the following Order for the public welfare:

1. Definition

In this order, unless the contrary intention appears:

“Commission” means the Commission of Inquiry established by this Order.

2. Appointment of Commissioner to the Commission of Inquiry

Jo Harry Karu is appointed as the Commissioner of the Commission of Inquiry.

3. Appointment of Assessor

Patrick Pene is appointed as an Assessor of the Commission of Inquiry.

4. Appointment of Secretary to the Commission of Inquiry

Amy Leiwa Taurakoto is appointed as the Secretary to the Commission of Inquiry.

5. Terms of reference

a) The terms of reference of the Commission are set out in Schedule 1 of this Order

b) The terms of reference of the Commission may be amended or varied by the Minister in consultation with the Commissioner.

6. Location of Inquiry

The inquiry is to be made at Port Vila and at such place or places as the Commissioner may determine.

7. Public inquiry

The inquiry is to be held in public except in circumstances as directed by the Commission who has authority to obtain, collect, record any classified material from any person being the holder of an office in the service of the Government.

8. Report


The Commissioner must prepare the following reports:

- a) A report of the proceedings and of the result of his inquiry to the Prime Minister, as the Minister for Justice not later than 30 September 2004.
- b) A report summarizing his findings and his recommendations available to the public not later than 7 days after the date of submission of his report to the Prime Minister

9. Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

SCHEDULE 1

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. The terms of reference of the Commission of inquiry are as follows.

- a) To inquire about foreign interferences and influences with persons holding an office in the service of the Republic of Vanuatu.
- b) To inquire about foreigners acting in a such way to interfere or influence persons holding an office in the service of the Government of Vanuatu.
- c) To inquire about facts establishing abuse of authority or capacity or position by persons or entities who have no jurisdiction within the Republic of Vanuatu.

d) To inquire about Vanuatu Maritime Authority activities

2. These terms of reference of the Commission of inquiry may be amended or varied by the Minister in consultation with the Commissioner.
