# **Meat Industry Regulations (Amendment)**

Order No. 12 of 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 28(q) of the Meat Industry Act No. 5 of 1991, I Honourable BARAK TAME SOPE, Minister for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries make the following Order.

#### 1 Amendments

The Meat Industry Regulations No. 9 of 1992 is amended as set out in the Schedule.

# **Ship Security Alert System Regulation**

Order No. 13 of 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 54 of the Vanuatu Maritime Authority Act No. 29 of 1998, I, the Honourable MAXIME CARLOT KORMAN, Minister of Infrastructure and Public Utilities, on the advice of the Authority, make the following Regulation.

# 1 Objective of Regulation

The objective of this Regulation is to promote compliance with safety standards in the maritime transport industry.

Requirement for installation of Ship Security Alert Systems (SSAS)
All owners or agents of foreign vessels of 500 gross tonnage or more which are registered under the Vanuatu International Ship Registry must install Ship Security Alert Systems on board their vessels to comply with the requirements of Chapter XI -2 of the SOLAS (Safety Of Lives At Sea).

#### 3 Type of system of alert

The type of system of alert required to be installed on board foreign vessels under Regulation 2 is the SHIPLOC/SSAS/CLS system that will comply with the IMO standards (MSC 76/4/1).

## 4 Enforcement of Regulation

The Vanuatu Maritime Authority and the Commissioner of Maritime Affairs must ensure that all foreign vessels comply with the requirements under Regulations 2 and 3 of this Regulation.

# 5 Penalty

Any person who acts in contravention to Regulations 2 and 3 after 6 months from the date of commencement of this Regulation. is liable to a fine of VT50, 000.

#### 6 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is made.
